We are delighted to welcome you in our accommodation.

In order to assure you the greatest safety, we have been extremely careful to respect all the sanitary instructions officially communicated to date.

Know that to avoid any contamination :

- All the contacts we have together will strictly respect the rules of social distancing to which we are trained ;
- The air conditioning filter is new ;
- We favour the regular cleaning of objects/surfaces by insisting on the most used surfaces: door handles, switches, stair ramp, remote control, toilet, shower and/or bath, washbasin, stair ramp, etc. with disinfectant products ;
- We ask you to wear a mask when travelling in traffic areas ;
- Hydroalcoholic gel is available in common areas ;
- Soap and tissue tissues are available in the rooms ;
- Meals and breakfasts will be served while respecting social distancing ;
- We will limit all contact, in particular by letting you carry your luggage ;
- You will find the keys to the room on the lock ;
- Well-being activities will be carried out in strict respect of barrier gestures by professionals ;

We cleaned the accommodation with gloves, a mask and according to a precise cleaning process and deep disinfection according to the information in force (household linen washed at the highest temperature, ventilated housing, disinfection of sanitary facilities, etc.).

HOW CAN YOU PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS



Regularly wash your hands with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser



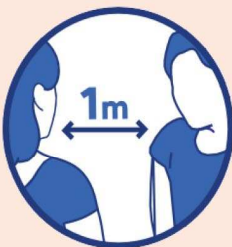
Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue

Avoid touching your face



Maintain at least 1 metre distance between yourself and others



Greet others without shaking hands and avoid hugging and kissing



In addition to these measures, wear a mask when a 1-metre distance cannot be maintained
